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EYFS/KS1 Reading Record Guidance

Children in EYFS and KS1 will bring home books that matches the level they are at in phonics. Children should read to a parent/carer at least three times per week. The parent/carer should then write a comment in the child's reading record.

When children read individually to an adult in school, the adult will also sign in the reading record.

Each time a child has three comments in their reading record, they will be awarded a starfish sticker.

When a child has 25 comments in their reading record they will be awarded with a certificate.

When a child has fifty comments in their reading record, they will be issued with a token to use in the library vending machine to select a free book!





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KS2 Accelerated Reading (AR) Guidance

The feedback that we received was that for older children, reading records were not seen to be having a positive impact on children's progress. Therefore, we will be using an online system already in place in school to monitor children's reading at home.

In the first week of each half-term, Y3-Y6 children complete a STAR reading test which provides us with a range that the children select books from. This level is then communicated to children and parents/carers.

Children then need to visit the library to select a book. This book will be taken home daily to read with a parent/carer.

Once a child has completed a book, they are to take responsibility for taking an AR quiz at school. If the child scores 80%+ then they can select another book. If the child scores less than 80% then they should speak to their class teacher. The class teacher then needs to help the child select the next book. If children continually do not pass the guizzes then they should take another STAR reading test to check they have been set the correct level.

We will be implementing the following incentives to encourage children to read and take AR quizzes.

100,000	Certificate
250,000	Certificate and starfish
500,000	Token for library vending machine
1,000,000	Special Star Prize

Quizzes Passed Based on data provided by AR	Reward
10	Certificate
25	Certificate and starfish
50	Token for library vending machine
100	Special Star Prize

Any certificates or awards will be presented in a weekly celebration worship.
