World Book Day is on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> March and we have an exciting day planned.

We will start the day with an assembly to introduce the theme of the day which will centre around our #makeadifference vision. Children will then be thinking about ways in which characters and books can make a difference.

Children will have an opportunity to share a book with a child from a different class and teachers might also be found sharing their favourite books in a different classroom!

To add to the day we are inviting children (and adults!) to dress up as a character who #makesadifference. This can be a fictional or real-life character. Speak to your child's class teacher if you are stuck for ideas.

From 2:30pm on this day, we will open classroom doors and you are welcome to come and share a book with your child. This is a great opportunity for the children to see adults loving books too!

These things might include:

Books, children's pyjamas, cuddly toys, biscuits, hot chocolate, marshmallows.

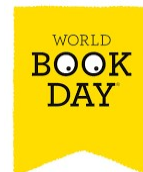
We will then organise for these to be taken to local charitable organisations.
